- * **Learn a Fingerstyle Melody** Bob will teach a beautiful finger style tune of his choice and get any level of guitarist playing it.
- * **Intro to Digital Recording** Clint will bring some gear, show you how to get started on your CD project, what you have to prepare and how to do it all on a budget.
- * **How to Play in a Band** This fun workshop could involve any one of the instructors. Get helpful tips on what your role is in a band situation on whatever instrument you play.
- * **Redd's Ramblings** We don't know what workshops he'll be teaching yet but whether he's showing you hot licks or talking about his musical experiences, you can be sure it'll be fabulous.
